Senior contest test piece: 5-7 minutes of music including at least one 4 part 2/4 March (rest own choice)

To be eligible for the Junior Contest, both players must be graded Sub-Intermediate or below. If either or both players are Intermediate or above they will play in the senior division.

The Junior Contest is planned to start at 7.30pm. so please arrive in time to be ready to play.
